



FIMP Research Call 2021

The FIMP (Fondazione Italiana per la ricerca sulle Malattie del Pancreas) was born in Verona with over 40 years of clinical and research experience. Today FIMP is at the forefront of promoting, developing and supporting research on pancreatic diseases.

FIMP awards € 25,000 for a scholarship/research grant for excellence in basic pre-clinical research in the areas of pancreatic ductal adenocarcinoma and related disciplines.

1. Extent of the support

The winner of the FIMP Research Call 2021

- receives the prize money of € 25,000 designated to support the future scientific research project. The prize money is paid to the winner's department/institution
- will officially be awarded during the Opening Session of the AISP (Associazione Italiana per lo Studio del Pancreas) annual meeting and will briefly present the winning project at this occasion.

2. Application criteria

- Applicants should be part of a research group and the work should be **conducted in Italy**

- Admitted degrees: Medicine Degree, Biology Degree, Biotechnology Degree, Pharmacy Degree
- **Age < 35 years** at the time of submission

3. Application process

Candidate must submit the completed application form by **6pm of May 28th 2021**

Applications received after the deadline of the call will not be considered valid.

Applications for admission to the selection, drawn up on plain paper and according to the scheme attached to this announcement (Annex A) and addressed to FIMP – Onlus, via Locatelli 20, 37122 Verona can be presented in one of the following modality:

1. **shipping by registered mail with return receipt** showing on the outside of the envelope the words "Notice of selection for assignment of research call FIMP 2021 "

2. **sending the documentation in pdf format, via Certified Electronic Mail (PEC),** to the e-mail address fimpancreas@legalmail.it

the sending can only be made from another certified e-mail

Application deadline at 6pm of May 28th 2021

In order to allow the evaluation the candidates can attach to the application (ANNEX A)

- a photocopy, in plain paper, of an identity document in progress validity.
- substitutive declaration of notarial deed of academic qualifications obtained (research doctorate and / or master's degree, specialist degree, or university degree) with the indication of the date and University of issue and any grade reported;
- scientific-professional curriculum, publications and qualifications that can be assessed on the basis of art. 4 announcement;

The aforementioned documentation must be produced within the deadline set for the

submission of applications, in unauthenticated photocopy and accompanied by the declaration of conformity with the originals, or the candidate may produce a self-certification stating the significant elements contained in these documents.

The administration reserves the right to carry out suitable checks on the veracity of the declarations replacement. If the checks indicated above reveal the untruthfulness of the contents of the declarations, the declarant decays from any benefits resulting from the provision issued on the basis of the untruthful declaration, without prejudice to the provisions of art. 76 of the Presidential Decree n.445/2000.

4. Selection process

- All applicants will be reviewed by the FIMP Research Committee.
- Main selection criteria are:
 1. Scientific merit (50%): Based on the track record and standard of the best 5 publications from the researcher over the last 10 years period.
 2. Research proposal (50%): Research plan, activity, aims and significance
- The criteria have no absolute delimitations and no legal weight.
- All applicants will be informed by e-mail about the status of their application by the beginning of July 2021

5. Obligations towards FIMP

The recipient of the FIMP Research Prize 2021 will be required to submit scientific reports on the work supported by the prize money.

Future publications related to the present project must report the support of the FIMP.
